Home Enrichment

If you're on a walk and hear a dog, ask your infant, "What do you hear?" suggests Gruhn. Then give the answer: "Dog. Bark. Ruff! Ruff!" Does this every time you encounter a barking dog and your child will probably start answering with the sound (Ruff! Ruff!), says Gruhn. Eventually, your infant will refine their response to "dog." Try a similar approach to teach them about physical sensations. If it starts drizzling while you're out, before you run for cover, let your infant experience the mist on their face. They won't melt. Say, "Feel the rain. Rain. Wet." Then cover the stroller and hustle home.
