## Toddler Class

We hope you all had a wonderful month of January. We are very excited to enter this new month with all of our friends in the Toddler classroom. Also we welcome our new friend Sam Montgomery, we are so happy to have him in our classroom. We will continue to learn new words to expand our vocabulary through the use of books, flashcards, and encourage repetition of simple words from the stories we read aloud. We will also continue to introduce and practice turning familiar pictures right side up. For our sign language curriculum we will be working on the baby signs for heart, bird, and love. We will teach this concept by signing to the children as we say the word out loud.

Number recognition and identification is another primary concept we are currently focusing on. We use books with numbers as well as counting the object the children are playing with, such as legos, blocks, and other manipulatives.

In addition we will be learning the colors: red, purple, pink, white. These colors will be incorporated in our valentine art projects throughout the month of February. Some of the projects we will be making include hearts and matching colors. These will help to review the colors red, yellow, green, and the numbers. Sensory and texture art will also be a large part of this month's art project s.

## Pre-K1 Class

We had fun in January and we have more exciting things planned for February. We are going to be changing the way we do share day. We won't be having everyone bring a toy on Fridays. We will have several themes going on this month. February is National Dental month so we will spend the first week talking about our teeth and how to care for them and talk about the dentist. We will be making some fun tooth brushes using glitter glue for the tooth paste and they will also be tracing and cutting out a tooth and labeling the parts of the tooth. Students will get to share their experiences of going to the dentist. We will also be reading books about other community helpers and students will be drawing pictures of their favorite helper and writing a little about them underneath.

You may have seen our dramatic play center which right now is a news station, Good Day Merryhill. The students have been having fun pretending to give the weather report and the news. We will continue this for another couple of weeks. Then we will be turning our dramatic play center into a zoo. Students will help design cages for their stuffed animals and a ticket booth. In math we will continue to work on our number recognition of numbers 20-40. We will also be doing some adding and subtracting with our counting bears. They have enjoyed working with our plastic coins and we will continue to work on coin recognition.

We will be working on sight word recognition by writing the words and sounding them out. We are also getting two sight words games from scholastic. It's going to be a fun busy month.

## Pre-K2 Class

Our Our Links to Learning Spanish curriculum this month will introduce new Febrero (February) vocabulary: Mini poster was sent home in your child's Links to Learning folders at the end of January. We will be focusing on learning how to greet each other appropriately, along with understanding magnetism, Magneti$c o$. Children will also be reviewing days of the week.

In mathematics we will be concentrating on reviewing how to count by fives to 100 . We will also continue to add groups together and subtract objects to obtain a total. We need lots of practice in this particular area!

We will continue to focus on vowel sounds this month. We are mostly already familiar with the five vowels and understand that vowels help make up words. Our Letter Buddies curriculum we have been working with is a great way for children to practice isolating and blending letter sounds.

This month our Social Emotional curriculum will be teaching us friendship skills and problem solving skills through role playing, story telling through puppets, and special games and songs. The students have been really enthusiastic when they hear the "sing along" CD being played, and often participate in the acting out of given scenarios.

Some new vocabulary words will be introduced to the children this month. We use vocabulary words in many ways, including: practicing printing, counting syllable sounds and vowels. Our vocabulary words this month are: February, Heart, Love, Cupid, Groundhog, Hibernation, Spring, and Valentine.

We will be having a party on Friday, February 13th! Bring your valentines!
