Skill Focus

- Responds to simple two-step directions
- Uses two to four word sentences
- Fills in words in familiar stories
- Names simple shapes and common colors
- Completes 1-3 piece puzzles through trial & error
- Finger paints with some control

Home Enrichment

Enhance your toddler's sense of adventure by treating small outings like adventurous journeys. Prepare by dressing for exploration – your toddler can wear a fire hat or carry a flashlight – and coming up with creative ways to pack snacks (like making a bracelet made of dry cereal strung on yarn). Have your child pick out a stuffed animal or doll to bring along as a traveling companion. And don't forget to bring back souvenirs – a "journey box" is the perfect distraction to pull out on a rainy day.
