Most of your early playtime will be spent showing your baby stuff. Any object in the house that won't hurt your child is fair game. Babies love egg beaters, spoons, wire whisks, spatulas, books and magazines with pictures, record albums, colorful fabrics or clothes, fruits and vegetables, and so on.

Keep a little stash of objects beside you and sit with your baby. When the moment's right, whip something out like a magician. Hold the object still about a foot from their face and stare at it yourself. Hey, now that you look at it, that bicycle bell is kind of interesting.
