## Home Enrichment

Sand and water

A bucket of water, a basin of sand, and a few cups and scoops can keep your child mesmerized for hours – and all along, he's learning about volume and texture, liquids and solids. Plus, it's engaging, so he'll develop persistence as he deals calmly with the fact that the water he's pouring into his carefully dug hole keeps disappearing.

Parent tip: Try open-ended questions to engage your child. ("Those sticks you added are standing in the sand all by themselves. I wonder why?")
