What you'll need: paper, masking tape, crayons

Tape some big sheets of thick paper onto the floor or a table and let your little one doodle to their heart's content. Start off with just a few crayons in primary colors. As your child picks up each crayon, name its color.

Shower your toddler's creations with praise. Your toddler will love seeing what he/she can do with the funny little colored sticks he/she used to chew on.

Skills developed: fine motor control, drawing, understanding cause and effect, and color identification
