Teach your parents or guardians the numbers 21–30. Read each number aloud and have your parents or guardians say it after you:

21 veintiuno	26 veintiséis
22 veintidós	27 veintisiete
23 veintitrés	28 veintiocho
24 veinticuatro	29 veintinueve
25 veinticinco	30 treinta

Make a set of number cards for the numbers 21–30. Write the number on one side and the Spanish word on the other side. Put the cards in order and hold them up one by one. Ask your parents or guardians to say the number—in Spanish!

Now add this set of cards to the one you made for the numbers 1–20 to play ¿Qué número es? Shuffle all of the cards and place them number-side up on a

table. Then take turns with your parents or guardians taking a card from the top of the pile and asking the question: ¿Qué número es? Whoever answers the question correctly using the expression Es el (number in Spanish) gets to keep the card. Continue until all thirty cards have been picked up. Whoever has the most cards at the end wins!

For more fun with numbers, look at the jar. How many jellybeans are in it? See who can count them the fastest in Spanish! Write the number on the line.
