

## **Big Island (Hawaii) Highlights**

From the raw power of active volcanoes at Volcanoes National Park to the captivating Punalu'u Black Sand Beach, where we might spot green sea turtles basking on the unique shore, and the marine wonders at Kealakekua Bay, we'll create lasting memories of this diverse and breathtaking natural paradise.



#### **Volcanoes National Park**

Study volcanology at the Kilauea Visitor Center, hike through volcanic craters, scalded deserts, and lush rainforests; walk into an actual lava tube and see two active volcanoes. This 300,000-acre national park is home to Kilauea Volcano, one of the most active volcanoes in the world!



#### Punalu'u Black Sand Beach

Visit one of the most famous black sand beaches in the world. These beaches get their color from volcanic lava contacting the ocean—as the lava cools rapidly, it shatters into small basalt fragments giving the beach its black color.



#### Kealakekua Bay

Board a catamaran for a cruise to Kealakekua Bay, a Marine Life Conservation District. Snorkel in the brilliant blue waters and see vibrant coral, tropical fish, and on occasion, spinner dolphins. The Bay has historical significance too, as it marks the spot Captain James Cook first landed on Hawaii Island in 1778.



#### Kilauea Iki Crater Hike

You'll start in a lush rainforest and descend to the floor of the Kilauea Iki Crater, a solidified lava lake which still contains many active steam vents. The vibrant colors and varied wildlife of the rainforest is a stark contrast to the steam vents, cinder cones, and splatter cones found in the crater.





### From the Big Island to Oahu

As we bid farewell to the enchanting landscapes of the Big Island, where we've explored the Halema'uma'u Crater, we transition to Oahu. There, we'll continue our educational journey with an ascent to the iconic Diamond Head, offering panoramic views of the Pacific. At Pearl Harbor, we'll pay our respects at the USS Arizona Memorial, and then immerse ourselves in Hawaiian culture with a traditional Luau and Polynesian Show.



#### Halema'Uma'U Crater

Located on the summit of Mount Kilauea, this underground lava lake has formed a crater that's nearly 3,000-feet in diameter and over 200-feet deep. Students will enjoy a night hike to the crater and stop along the way for stargazing in the pitch-black, unpolluted sky.



#### **Diamond Head**

Climb the 99 stairs to the top of Diamond Head, a well-known landmark of the Honolulu Volcanic Series. This 763-foot volcanic tuff cone summit boasts an exhilarating 360-degree panoramic view!



#### **USS Arizona**

The USS Arizona Memorial, at Pearl Harbor in Honolulu, Hawaii, marks the resting place of 1,102 of the 1,177 sailors and Marines killed on USS Arizona during the Japanese surprise attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, and commemorates the events of that day.




#### Hawaiian Luau and Polynesian Show

# On-Site Swimming Lessons (Rising Intermediate – Rising 9<sup>th</sup>)

Our on-site swimming lessons are beneficial for children of beginner to intermediate skill levels. In our lessons, children learn foundational water safety skills, refine their swim technique, build self confidence, and work towards reaching their personal swimming goals. Our experienced, qualified instructors help children practice their freestyle, breaststroke, and butterfly stroke techniques.

# Camper Daily Swim (Rising 1<sup>st</sup> – Rising 9<sup>th</sup> Grade)

Our rising 1st – 9th grade campers have an opportunity to enjoy daily swim as part of their camp program. Campers swim Monday – Friday, with an exception of campus events, specialty clubs, and field trips. Campers are not required to swim; however, they will need to remain with their student group. This a great time for students to not only have fun with their peers but also practice their swimming skills.

#### **Aquatics Safety**

Swimming is a fun and essential life skill for children of all ages. We provide students with the skills and experiences needed to feel confident in the water. Our personalized teaching approach allows each child to learn swimming skills comfortably and safely at their own pace. Children learn the features of a safe swimming environment and important safety habits, such as never swimming alone or without adult supervision.

Swimming is an important life skill, and learning to swim should be fun and engaging! #### **Swimming Lessons**

Campers learn foundational water safety skills, refine their swim technique, build self-confidence, and work towards reaching their personal swimming goals. The students will understand the fundamentals of Water Basketball, while increasing their swimming skills. Students must have swim experience to join. Must be a level 3 and up swimmer to join.

# On-site Pool & Swimming Lessons

#### Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills

- For the beginner who is comfortable in the water.
- Swimmers learn basics of swimming: bobbing, going under water, supported front and back floating, supported rolling over from front to back and back to front, supported gliding, supported flutter kick, supported front crawl arms and jumping in.

#### Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills

- Swimmers should already be able to float on front and back and put their head under water.
- Swimmers will work on independent front and back floating, independent rolling over from front to back and back to front, independent front and back glides, front crawl arms and kicks, back crawl arms and kicks, retrieving underwater objects, and jumping into water over their head.

#### Level 3: Stroke Development

- Swimmers should already be comfortable swimming front stroke and swimming on their back.
- Swimmers will work on gliding, freestyle with side breathing, backstroke, breaststroke and dolphin kicks, retrieving objects in deeper water, treading and jumping into water.

#### Level 4: Stroke Improvement

- Swimmers should already be able to: swim front and back crawl 25 yards.
- Swimmers will work on rotary breathing, freestyle, backstroke, elementary backstroke, scissors kick and sidestroke, whip kick and breaststroke, intro to turning at wall, treading water with modified scissors, and diving in kneeling position.

#### Level 5: Stroke Refinement

- Swimmers should already be able to: swim freestyle, breaststroke and backstroke 25 yards, scissors kick, whip kick, treading water, and dive.
- Swimmers will work on alternate breathing, stride jump, refinement of freestyle, backstroke, elementary backstroke, sidestroke, breaststroke, dolphin kick and butterfly, open turn on front and back, feet-first surface dive, and treading water.

#### Level 6: Swimming & Skill Proficiency

- Swimmers should already be able to: swim front and back crawl 50 yards, elementary backstroke 25 yards, breaststroke 25 yards, butterfly 25 yards, sidestroke 10 yards, and tread water for 3 minutes.
- Swimmers will work on: All six strokes, front and back crawl flip turn, breaststroke turn, breaststroke speed turn and pullout, butterfly turn, sidestroke turn, tread water for five minutes, and basic water rescue. (Please note: All diving requirements have been removed.)

#### **Forms**

Please contact Merryhill Calvine administrators at 1037adminteam@nlcinc.com, if you have any questions regarding required forms. Campers will not be permitted to attend Summer Camp at Merryhill Calvine without the required forms on file, by their start date.

#### **Payment**

One week's tuition and the registration fee is due at the time of enrollment. The deposit will be applied to the final week of camp. Weekly camp fees are due every Monday. A \$25 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday.

#### **Cancelation**

If you enroll in camp and/or specialty camps and your plans change, or you have concerns about your child attending camp this summer, you can receive a full refund/credit for camp tuition, less registration fee. Program change request must be received 2 weeks prior to enrolled camp week or scheduled specialty camp start date. Participants who do not attend their registered camp week, or who do not contact us to cancel two weeks prior to start date, will not receive a refund or credit. By submitting your payment, you are agreeing to the policy outlined above.

#### Lunch (Rising Kindergarten – Rising 9th Grade)

Rising kindergarten - 9th grade campers will need to bring a healthy morning, afternoon snack, and lunch daily. Lunch and snacks are only provided for the preschool camp program. You can purchase a snack card for your child at the front desk. With this \$5, \$10, or \$20 card, campers can purchase AM or PM snacks from our snack cart (50¢ for snacks, \$1 for ice cream). We are a nut free school!

#### Sunscreen & Labeled Items
