Lace up your dancing shoes and let's boogie! Campers show off their inner performer and express themselves through dance, drama, and music!



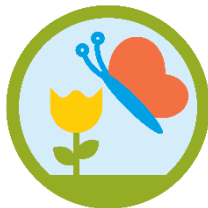
Storybook Summer

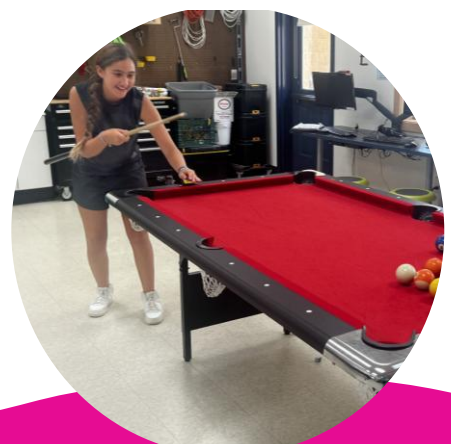

ACADEMIC CAMPS

Keep learning while having fun! • Rising K – Rising 9th

Academic camps are a wonderful way to enhance your child's love of learning while focusing on a specific subject. From math and robotics to literature and creative writing, we have something for every student. Campers work independently and in small groups to apply real-life experiences to lessons learned in the classroom.

Kindergarten Prep

Step into the crucial pre-kindergarten months with Kindergarten Enrichment: A Pre-K to K Adventure! This program bridges the transition from preschool to kindergarten, laying the foundation for a lifelong love of learning.

We work on sharpening literacy and math skills, while also providing opportunities for your child to practice kindergarten etiquette through authentic play and collaborative learning.

Academic Enrichment- Small Group

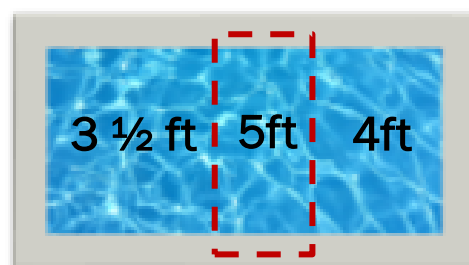

On-Site Swimming Lessons- Sign up

Our on-site swimming lessons are beneficial for children of beginner to intermediate skill levels. In our lessons, children learn foundational water safety skills, refine their swim technique, build self confidence, and work towards reaching their personal swimming goals. Our experienced, qualified instructors help children practice their freestyle, breaststroke, and butterfly stroke techniques.

Aquatics Safety

Swimming is a fun and essential life skill for children of all ages. We provide students with the skills and experiences needed to feel confident in the water. Our personalized teaching approach allows each child to learn swimming skills comfortably and safely at their own pace. Children learn the features of a safe swimming environment and important safety habits, such as never swimming alone or without adult supervision.



SWIM CLINIC

Ages 8 – 12

Swimming is an important life skill, and learning to swim should be fun and engaging! Whether a camper is learning to swim, improving their strokes, or preparing for a competitive league, this clinic is designed to be highly effective with adaptive teaching to support ultimate growth. We are excited to offer this swim camp that gives a personalized touch to learning how to swim faster and safer, while having fun in the pool. Students will receive longer swim lessons as a group and through semi-private instruction. They will participate in the introductory programs of various activities and sports each week. Finally, they will end each day with a water safety class of learning how to be safe around the pool and the beginning lessons of lifeguarding.

Campers can sign up for this 3-hour program only or in conjunction with our day camp, utilizing the entire camp day, including Friday.

Rising Intermediate – Rising 9th Grade

Swimming Lessons

Campers learn foundational water safety skills, refine their swim technique, build self-confidence, and work towards reaching their personal swimming goals. Our experienced, qualified instructors help children practice their freestyle, breaststroke and butterfly stroke techniques. Our swimming lessons are for children of beginner to intermediate skill levels. Lessons are hosted for 30 minutes daily, throughout the camp day. A total of 10 lessons per session.

Grades: Rising Intermediate – 9th Grade

Water Basketball

Come and try Water Basketball! This is a sport that your child will love if they enjoy fast-paced water games. Our Water Basketball club is designed to develop water confidence and swim strength. The students will understand the fundamentals of Water Basketball, while increasing their swimming skills. Students must have swim experience to join. Must be a level 3 and up swimmer to join.

Grades: Rising 3rd – 6th Grade

Session/Weeks: 2 and 4 (June 16- June 27 & July 14- July 25)

Price: \$95



Splash Zone

Strap on your goggles and get ready to have some fun! In Splash Zone, you never know what game/activity will come next. From water relays to diving activities, and more. Just be ready to enjoy the water, while being pushed to the limits. Students must have swim experience to join. Must be a level 3 and up swimmer to join. Clubs are hosted throughout the camp day.

Grades: Rising 3rd – 6th Grade

Session/Weeks: 3 and 5 (June 30-July 11 & July 28- August 8)

On-site Pool and Swimming Lessons

Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills

- For the beginner who is comfortable in the water.
- Swimmers learn basics of swimming: bobbing, going under water, supported front and back floating, supported rolling over from front to back and back to front, supported gliding, supported flutter kick, supported front crawl arms and jumping in.

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills

- Swimmers should already be able to float on front and back and put their head under water.
- Swimmers will work on independent front and back floating, independent rolling over from front to back and back to front, independent front and back glides, front crawl arms and kicks, back crawl arms and kicks, retrieving underwater objects, and jumping into water over their head.

Level 3: Stroke Development

- Swimmers should already be comfortable swimming front stroke and swimming on their back.
- Swimmers will work on gliding, freestyle with side breathing, backstroke, breaststroke and dolphin kicks, retrieving objects in deeper water, treading and jumping into water.

Level 4: Stroke Improvement

- Swimmers should already be able to: swim front and back crawl 25 yards.
- Swimmers will work on rotary breathing, freestyle, backstroke, elementary backstroke, scissors kick and sidestroke, whip kick and breaststroke, intro to turning at wall, treading water with modified scissors, and diving in kneeling position.

Level 5: Stroke Refinement

- Swimmers should already be able to: swim freestyle, breaststroke and backstroke 25 yards, scissors kick, whip kick, treading water, and dive.
- Swimmers will work on alternate breathing, stride jump, refinement of freestyle, backstroke, elementary backstroke, sidestroke, breaststroke, dolphin kick and butterfly, open turn on front and back, feet-first surface dive, and treading water.

Level 6: Swimming & Skill Proficiency

- Swimmers should already be able to: swim front and back crawl 50 yards, elementary backstroke 25 yards, breaststroke 25 yards, butterfly 25 yards, sidestroke 10 yards, and tread water for 3 minutes.
- Swimmers will work on: All six strokes, front and back crawl flip turn, breaststroke turn, breaststroke speed turn and pullout, butterfly turn, sidestroke turn, tread water for five minutes, and basic water rescue. (Please note: All diving requirements have been removed.)
