## Forms

## Payment

Weekly camp fees are due every Monday. A \$25 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday.

## Cancellation

If you enroll in camp and your plans change, you can receive a full refund/credit for camp tuition, less registration fee. **Program changes are made by the parent through the camp registration portal only and must be received 2 weeks prior to the camp start date.** Participants who do not attend their registered camp week, or who do not cancel two weeks prior to start date, will not receive a refund or credit. By submitting your payment, you are agreeing to the policy outlined above.

## Lunch

Morning snack, lunch, and afternoon snack are provided by the school. A menu is available for review in advance. If your child has any allergies or food restrictions, please be sure to provide an alternative. Additionally, please ensure that your camper has a refillable water bottle every day.

## Sunscreen

Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to coming to camp each day. Sunscreen will be reapplied in the afternoon, or as needed. A signed permission form is required for sunscreen application.


