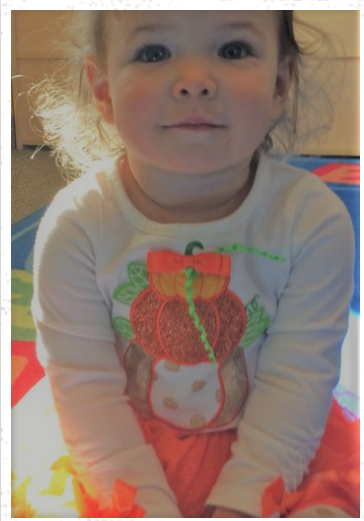

Recipes can be anything from tradition related to easy weeknight dinners to semi-homemade quick snacks, etc.

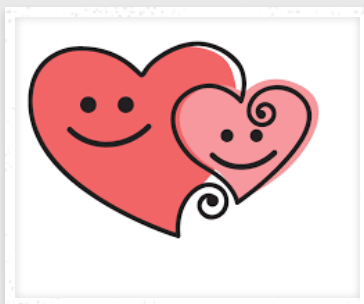

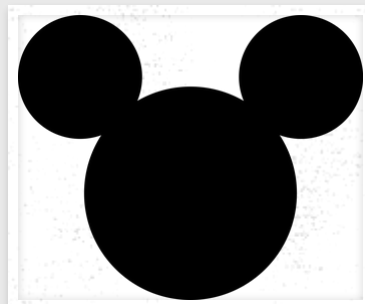

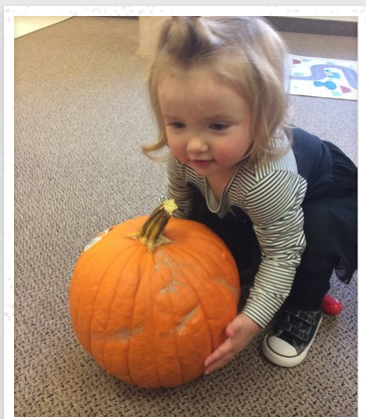
PICTURE DAY!!!

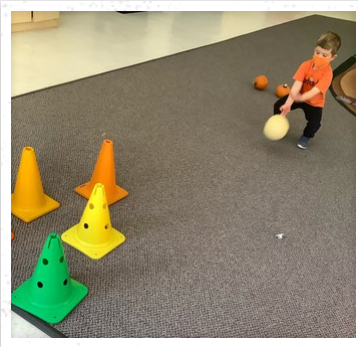

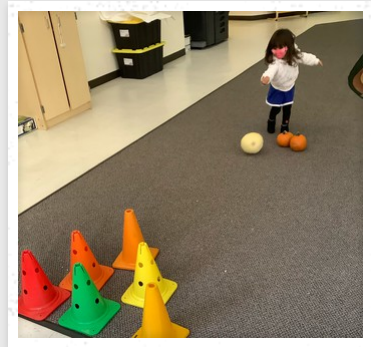

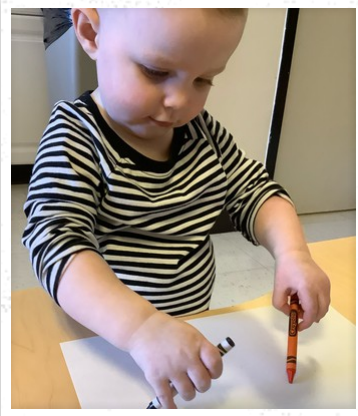

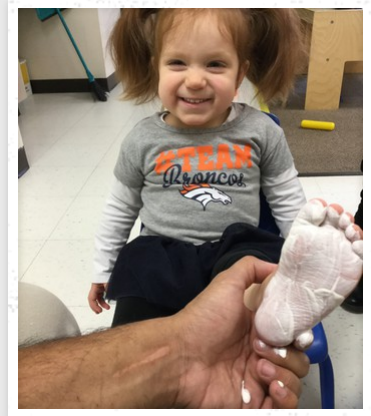

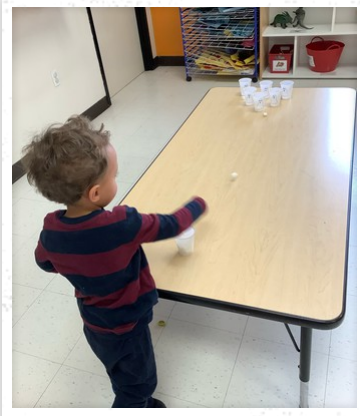

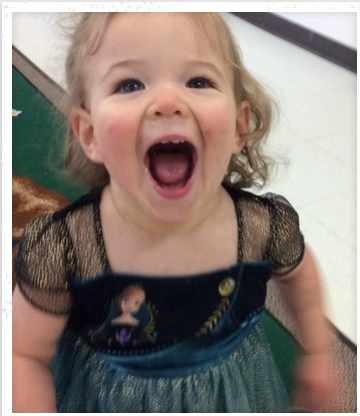

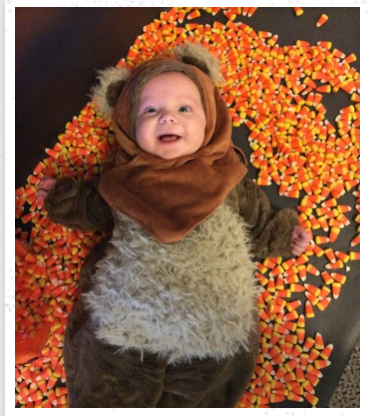
