Our Before & After School Programs offer students enriching opportunities for discovery and exploration before and after the normal school day hours. These programs provide numerous options for fun while also reinforcing the essential lessons and values taught throughout the school day.





## **Extended Day**

Our Extended Day program allows busy working families the flexibility to drop-off before the school day starts and pick-up after the normal dismissal time. Our program is organized into five subject areas that are designed to provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills, and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day, while providing plenty of time for fun with friends.

#### **Program Details:**

- Hours: 7:00 am 6:00 pm
- **Study Hall:** Children complete homework in their classroom with their teacher.
- Snack Cart: Nutritious and delicious snacks to help children form healthy eating habits.
  Snack options and ice cream are available at an additional cost for the students to enjoy in the after-school program.
- Breakout Sessions: Themed activities and student choice and voice provided by our very own teacher assistants and before/after care staff.

### **Clubs & Enrichment**

Our Clubs and Enrichment Programs are great ways for your child to expand on their interests or pursue new passions. These can be added in conjunction with our Extended Day Program or independently. This program offers families an opportunity to enroll their student in one or more days of after school activities without leaving the convenience of our campus.

# **Extended Day**

Our program is organized into five subject areas that are designed to provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day.









Students explore the exciting world of science, technology, engineering, art and math (STEAM) through building projects, experiments, and design challenges. Sharing ideas, asking questions, and making predictions are encouraged!



Robust outdoor free play and structured games help students learn sportsmanship and develop their physical strength and endurance. Students learn critical thinking and problem solving by participating in board games and team challenges with their peers.



Students express themselves by participating in hands-on visual arts, including photography, videography, drawing, and painting. Students develop planning skills by working on long-term projects with their peers and can participate in group performances or discussions.



Social and emotional growth is nurtured through student and teacher led activities that promote a feeling of community and belonging. Students learn through open-ended activities that give them a chance to apply problem-solving skills and collaborate with friends.



Some students appreciate the chance for independent activities or study after a long day at school. We provide a quiet place to work on homework, read, journal, or seek academic support from peers and teachers. Students can also work on various projects in this small group setting.

## **Terms and Agreements**

#### **Registration and Payment**

- The acceptable forms of payment for clubs are checks, credit card, or money orders made payable to Merryhill School Calvine.
- Students not enrolled in After School Academy (before/after care) can register for clubs for \$30.00 more than the advertised price.
- Payment for all clubs is due by the Monday after the registration period has closed.
- Please note: You will not be able to see the transaction in your Alma account, until the registration period has closed. At this time, your account will be billed.

#### **Refunds**

- Once the registration period has closed, and a club session has started, changes may not be made, and your account will be billed.
- Student participation and club fees are non-refundable or transferable to a different club.
- A refund will not be rewarded or rescheduled due to a holiday or an in-service day.
- We will only accept the maximum number of students indicated on the sign-up sheet. There is a maximum enrollment size for each club due to safety and the materials purchased.
- If the minimum number for enrollment is not met, a club may be cancelled. If a club is cancelled, a refund will be rewarded, or the amount can be used for future club enrollment and will be kept on the account.
- A refund will not be rewarded for disruptive behavior (please review the policy on the next page).

#### **Clubs Meeting Dates and Times**

- When signing up for clubs, please be aware of the times and days clubs are offered to avoid any scheduling conflicts.
- Piano/Guitar lessons, Swim lessons, and tutoring sessions (when offered) are scheduled around the student's activity schedule, to the best of our abilities. Requested times are not guaranteed.
- For tutoring (when offered), requested days and times are not guaranteed. Available subject and requested subjects are based upon teacher availability.
- We will make every attempt to accommodate a preferred lesson time; however, clubs/lessons are filled on a "first-come, first-service basis."

## **Terms and Agreements**

#### **Late Policy**

- A late charge will be assessed to your account if your child(ren) are on campus after their scheduled dismissal time.
  - Child not enrolled in the after-school program: 3:15 pm
  - Child enrolled in the after-school program: 6:00 pm
- If your child has a scheduled club, and they are not enrolled in before/after care, they stay on campus until their club has dismissed.
- Parents, who pick up after their scheduled dismissal time, will be charged \$5.00 per minute. A contact on your child's emergency card will be notified at 6:00 pm. Your child(ren) will wait for their arrival in the front office.

### **Club Attendance**

- Students must attend the school day to participate in all clubs, including practices, games, and performances. Students who do not attend the school day, will not be accepted to participate in After School Academy clubs and other lessons or activities unless unique circumstances have been approved prior by the After School Administrator.
- For clubs or any lessons, there will be no credit or reduction in fees granted for absences, vacations, illness, etc.
- If your child is present at school and is not attending a scheduled club or lesson, please inform the After School Administrator and/or the club leader.
- Clubs, sport games/practices, music lessons, swim lessons, or tutoring sessions will not be rescheduled due to your child's absence.
- If a club instructor is absent or unable to lead the scheduled club or lesson, a make-up session will be scheduled and communicated in a timely fashion by the club leader.
- Unfortunately, there are no trial periods for any clubs, unless otherwise indicated. We apologize for the inconvenience this may cause you.

## **Terms and Agreements**

#### **Club Attire**

- Student athletes or performers are required to wear their assigned jersey, club shirt, or uniform, and bring their required equipment to participate in a sporting event or performance.
- Students who are not dressed in their required uniform or have their required equipment, will be asked to stay to support their team; however, they will not be eligible to participate.

#### Responding to Disruptive Behavior

- For the safety and enjoyment of all children enrolled in *After School Academy*, appropriate behavior is required.
- Children are expected to comply with all regular school rules and regulations during after school hours.
- At the discretion of the club instructor or After School Academy Administrator, and/or School Administrator, a child displaying disruptive or inappropriate behavior will be asked to leave the club.
- Parents will receive an email and/or an incident report by the club instructor.
- Children whose behavior is deemed disruptive again, may be withdrawn from the club for that session.
- A child may be removed from a club at any time at the discretion of the administration. No refunds will be given in this case.

#### **Inclement Weather Policy and Cancellations**

- We will attempt to hold a make-up session when a club is cancelled due to inclement weather, but it is not always possible.
- No refunds will be given for weather conditions.



#### **Private Tutoring**

Our private tutoring sessions are one-on-one and are led by our MSC teachers and staff. We offer hands-on use of manipulatives to help foster learning in language arts (reading, writing, and phonics), math, science, social studies. The tutoring staff will meet with current classroom teachers to discuss current needs and topics of focus.


